OUR FLEET

The City of Talent has 22 vehicles in its fleet. These vehicles serve our Police, Public Works, and Administration Departments.

Having a well-maintained fleet is essential to ensuring the health and safety of our employees, our residents, as well as for the efficient operation of the City of Talent.

FLEET OVERVIEW

- Average Age: 12 years. The oldest vehicle in Talent's fleet is 24 years old.
- Average Mileage: 89,006 miles. A truck in the Public Works Department has over 213,000 miles on the odometer.
- **High Annual Maintenance Costs:** Costly repairs are made even worse by supply chain issues and long lead times.
- Used or Donated Vehicles: 6 of the City of Talent's vehicles have been donated USED by other municipalities who found that it was not in their best interest to retain the vehicles due to high mileage or increased repair costs. 3 vehicles were purchased used.
- Low Resale Values: Most of Talent's fleet has low resale value to high mileage, high amount of wear and tear, and numerous cosmetic issues.

FLEET REPLACEMENT POLICY

The City of Talent has had a policy for vehicle replacement for nearly 2 years. The last time it was updated was in January 2024. The fleet data in the policy should be updated and reviewed prior to the formulation of the annual budget.



VEHICLE REPLACEMENT SCORING


- 1 to 15 Points No need to replace.
- 16 to 21 Points Prepare for replacement in 3 to 5 years.
- 22 to 27 Points Needs to be replaced now.

Higher the score, the more urgent the replacement





VEHICLE REPLACEMENT STRATEGY



- Starting in 2027-28, it will be recommended that two vehicles will be replaced each year.
- Vehicle scoring as outlined in the policy will be used as a guide. Management will decide which vehicles will need to be replaced.
- Purchases will be financed either through a lease or a loan to minimize impact on cash flow.
- Grants for vehicle replacements will be sought.
- Purchases for new vehicles will be encouraged due to reliability and less expensive financing.
- Fuel efficiency is important. Hybrid or EV vehicles will be considered.

FISCAL IMPACT

Vehicle replacements and purchases for the fiscal year 2024-25 have been planned and budgeted for. These purchases will be financed and not cash purchased.

Vehicle replacements for the 2025-26 fiscal year have been identified but will solidify only after updating the Fleet Replacement Policy and after having a firm understanding of the City of Talent's financial situation.

Donated by Avista. Needs front end work. Air conditioning not working. No emergency radio. Hard to start. Transmission problems. Shuts off when idling.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2026-27 fiscal year.



PUBLIC WORKS 2004 CHEVY SILVERADO

20 years old 78,191 miles

The front-end needs work. Needs new seats and new steering wheel. Bed is rusting. Needs emergency lights and new tailgate. Fuel pump out. Will not start.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2027-28 fiscal year.




PUBLIC WORKS 2004 FORD F550 DUMP TRUCK

20 years old 27,050 miles

Purchased new. Hydraulic pump needs to be replaced. Tailgate malfunctions. Needs new brakes on the front. Needs an emergency light bar.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2030-31 fiscal year.



PUBLIC WORKS 2005 TOYOTA TUNDRA

19 years old 105,636 miles

Purchased used. Needs repairs to exhaust system and the heater core leaks. Drivers side window will not roll down.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2028-29 fiscal year.



PUBLIC WORKS 2006 FORD F350

18 years old 62,060 miles

Purchased new. Needs tow package, heater core is leaking, possibly needs new brakes, and the transmission shifts hard in second gear. Fuel economy is extremely poor.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2029-30 fiscal year.

PUBLIC WORKS 2008 FORD F350

16 years old 85,475 miles

Purchased new. Burns a quart of oil per month. Power steering going out. Front end needs repair. Needs new front seat. Windshield wipers do not work. Currently on its third engine.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2024-25 fiscal year.




POLICE 2009 DODGE CHARGER

Estimated to be replaced in the 2031-32 fiscal year.




POLICE 2014 CHEVY TAHOE

Check engine light is back on. Very poor mechanical shape. Has been in 3 accidents due to pursuits.

To be replaced in the 2024-25 fiscal year.

POLICE 2015 FORD TAURUS

9 years old 146,300 miles

The upholstery is torn, roof trim lifting, visible scratches and exterior dings.

Estimated to be replaced in the 2026-27 fiscal year.




POLICE 2016 FORD EXPLORER

Estimated to be replaced in the 2027-28 fiscal year.




POLICE 2021 FORD EXPLORER HYBRID
