ISSUE BEFORE THE COUNCIL

Establish Lease Rates for City of Talent & Urban Renewal Agency Properties

BACKGROUND

At their meetings of June 5, the City Council and TURA tentatively approved lease rates and policies concerning City and TURA properties. The City/TURA own four locations where space is leased to non-profit organizations for ongoing operations. The City Council and TURA directed staff to return to the City Council and TURA with a Resolutions establishing a standard lease rate for City-owned property used by non-profit organizations for office purposes at 75 per cent of the market rate, as determined by a survey of comparable space rentals conducted every two years. Effective July 1, 2024, said rate shall be \$1.10 per square foot per month.

The Council also voted to retain the current practice of leasing non-office space to non-profit organizations (i.e. ACCESS, Historical Society) at a rate determined on a case-by-case basis.

Resolution 2024-096-R adopts the above-described rate schedule and policy.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-096-R

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING LEASE RATES FOR CITY OF TALENT OWNED PROPERTIES USED BY NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council met on June 5, 2024, and tentatively approved lease rates and policies for properties owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Talent owns property where space is leased to non-profit organizations for ongoing operations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to return with a resolution establishing a standard lease rate for City-owned property used by non-profit organizations for office purposes at 75 percent of the market rate, as determined by a survey of comparable space rentals conducted every two years; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2024, the rate for office space leased to non-profit organizations shall be set at \$1.10 per square foot per month; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has voted to retain the current practice of leasing non-office space to non-profit organizations, such as ACCESS and the Historical Society, at a rate determined on a case-by-case basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Talent, as follows:

- 1. The standard lease rate for City-owned property used by non-profit organizations for office purposes shall be established at 75 percent of the market rate, as determined by a survey of comparable space rentals conducted every two years.
- 2. Effective July 1, 2024, the lease rate for office space used by non-profit organizations shall be \$1.10 per square foot per month.
- 3. The current practice of leasing non-office space to non-profit organizations at a rate determined on a case-by-case basis shall be retained.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council.
